Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, our Stay and Play sessions ran for more than a decade and were very popular within our local community. Our volunteers will be working alongside two of our highly experienced school leaders. We will be running a session each Tuesday during term time. Once the session is well-established we hope to run a second session at the end of the week. The role of Stay and Play Volunteer includes a range of responsibilities, which include, setting up activities, welcoming families upon arrival, supporting children and families to engage with focus activities, tidying up and supporting the Group Leader during singing sessions.
